Dr. Neil is the CEO of Bahamas Plastic Surgery, a busy plastic and reconstructive surgery practice in Nassau, Bahamas. In addition to his office practice, he runs a private Surgical Center and holds privileges at Doctors Hospital in Nassau Bahamas where he is presently the Chief of Surgical Services.
